Poster Contest 2018 Guidelines

Conference Theme: Oh, the places you'll go with languages!

(The theme itself does NOT need to be written on the poster.)

Illustrate the theme above with your own artwork. Create an original **one dimensional** poster that promotes/encourages learning world languages. Avoid emphasis on only one language other than English.

Size: Standard 8 x 11 inch paper

Color: Black & White (ink or pencil) or Color (colored pencils, markers, crayons, water colors)

Format: Horizontal or Vertical
Please note that nothing may be cut and glued onto the poster.

Art Work: Art work must be original. Designs and figures must be drawn free hand. They may NOT be traced. Registered logos, trademarks and/or figures may NOT be featured on the posters.

Divisions: Elementary (K-5)
Middle School (6-8)
High School (9-12)

Prizes:	1st place in each division	\$ 75.00
	2nd place in each division	\$ 50.00
	3rd place in each division	\$ 35.00
	Overall Winner	\$ 100.00

All checks will be sent directly to the students, not the teachers or the school.

Entries: Schools may only submit three (3) entries per division.

Each entry should be accompanied by a completed entry form glued onto the back of the poster. (The entry form may be photocopied onto the back of the poster.) **Please write all the information digitally on the submitted form to avoid any misspelling errors (sent any other way will make the entry disqualified).**

Student/teacher checklist for entries

- To what degrees does the poster illustrate the conference theme?
- Does the poster encourage YOU and OTHERS to learn another language?
- Does the artwork conform to the poster guidelines? Original, one dimensional, etc.
- Is there something I need to do in order to improve my poster? Define or outline figures or the message? Fill in the background? Add more color or create better black & white contrast?
- Does MY poster reflect my best effort? Is it quality work (appropriate to division)?
- Am I proud to submit MY poster to the IFLTA Poster Contest?
